Diana Baumrind (1991) believes parents interact with their children in one of three basic ways, that is, authoritarian, authoritative, or permissive. Authoritarian parenting expects the child to follow the parent's directions and to respect work and effort. The authoritarian parent strictly limits and controls the child and does not allow any discussion. For example, when there is a difference in opinion as to how to do something, the authoritarian parent might say, "You do it my way or else..." Children of authoritarian parents are often anxious about being compared to others, lack initiative and have poor communication skills.

Authoritative parenting encourages children to be independent but still limits and controls their behavior. A lot of verbal give-and-take is allowed and parents are supportive and warm towards the child. An authoritative parent might put his arm around the child in a comforting way and say, "You know you should not have done that ; let's talk about how you can handle the situation better next time." Children whose parents are authoritative tend to be well-adjusted, self-reliant and socially responsible.

Permissive parenting places few demands or controls on the child. Such parents let their children do what they want, and the result is the children never learn to control their own behavior. They always expect to get their own way. When they cannot get what they want, they may either lose their temper or throw tantrums. Such children also do not learn to respect others.
